Skills Needed:

Ministry Cost:

Housing: Mission teams will stay at our ministry center outside of Marion on Hwy. 45. Team members will need to bring pillows, twin bed linens, or a sleeping bag. To help offset the cost of utilities, the cost per person is \$12 per night.

Meals: Teams will have access to the center's kitchen and will be responsible for the planning, purchase, and preparation of meals during their stay in the Queen City. Wal-Mart, Winn Dixie, and Sam's Club are in close driving distance.

Ministry materials: Queen City Mission will provide the Vacation Bible School and Back Yard Bible Club curriculum. Groups are asked to supply materials for games, crafts, block party door prizes, etc. Other material needed will be based upon the mission project the team participates in,
