MS BIBLE DRILL AWARDS

CERTIFICATES

Each driller is awarded a certificate for participating in Bible Drills. Church leaders are to complete and mail/email the "Report Form" that is attached to the Church Drill packet. This form is used to record participation and to request certificates/seals for the drillers.

SEALS

One seal is awarded to each driller, per year, to designate the highest level of participation for that year. Drillers who do not qualify or choose not to participate in the Association Drill will be awarded a "Church Participant" seal. Drillers who do not qualify or choose not to participate in the State drill will be awarded an "Association Participant" seal. (All Church and Association seals will be mailed to the participant's church upon receipt of the "Report Form").

Students who participate in the State Drill will receive one of the following seals:

- 0-2 Mistakes: Superior 3-4 Mistakes: Excellent
- 5-6 Mistakes: Good
- 7 or More Mistakes: State Participant

STATE AWARDS (ONLY GIVEN AT THE STATE DRILLS)

Ribbons are given to first year drillers in children's or student bible drills.

Medallions are awarded to drillers in their FINAL year of Children's Bible Drills.

(no matter how many years in Children's drills, this award will be given in their final year of this category)

Plaques are awarded to drillers in their **<u>FINAL year of the Student Bible Drill</u>**. (no matter how many years in Student drills, this award will be given in their final year of this category) **Name plates** will still be provided for these plaques, but there will be NO year plates.

9 Year Drillers are awarded a KJV or CSB study bible.

Bible Drill Tournament Awards

1. 9 YEAR SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT

These scholarships are awarded, by the schools, to the winners of the 9 Year Scholarship Tournament ONLY, with the exception of the *Participation Award*.

Scholarships for Bible Drill and Speakers Tournament cannot be combined

*Students may participate in this tournament only once. They can choose to participate their 9th or 10th year drills)

******Participation Scholarships - How to apply? (all 3 schools)

To apply for this award, the student's church must recommend him or her, by letter to the corresponding school, certifying the number of years of participation in Bible Drill.

All Scholarships are non-transferable. Each college reserves the right to modify the requirements. Scholarships and policies are subject to change without notice.

Please note: It is up to the individual college as to its policies on receiving multiple scholarships.

2. HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT (Grades 10-12)

This is a one-time award that is good for any college or university the student chooses to attend. **1st Place Winner**: \$1,000 Scholarship **2nd Place Winner**: \$750 Scholarship **3rd Place Winner**: \$500 Scholarship

*Drillers can participate each year, however, he/she will be awarded only <u>one</u> scholarship (the highest they place.)

3. MIDDLE SCHOOL TOURNAMENT (Grades 6-9)
