## TRAINING FOR HOUSE CHURCH LEADERS

Since 2012, Missions Mobilization has connected with East Asia to provide training for house church leaders. Pastors, Student ministers, Education and Music Ministers, as well as experienced, qualified laypersons have been involved in teaching leadership development courses as needed to aid in equipping those who will then pass on that teaching to others.

The curriculum outlines are provided to students and are translated into their language. Each teacher receives the outlines in advance so that he may flesh out the material with a strong emphasis on practicality and application. Some of the topics that have been a part of the teaching modules are: Old Testament, New Testament, Doctrine-Theology, Spiritual Formation, Teaching/Preaching, Hermeneutics, and others.

Teachers usually travel together and teach in pairs. The pairs depart from Mississippi late Sunday evening or early Monday morning and arrive in East Asia late on Tuesday evening. The following day, the team travels to various settings to teach a 3-4 day conference, rest and travel a day, and then teach a second 3-4 day conference. The team travels home by Saturday, completing a 13-day journey, missing only one Sunday from church.

The cost for participation on a leadership team is between \$1500-1700, depending on the cost of the airline tickets, plus the cost of the entry visa, which is approximately \$285. Ten-year, multiple entry visas are now available and are issued dependent upon the validity of the passport. Missions Mobilization covers the balance of the cost of travel, arranges travel logistics, and assists with visa application process.
