MAKING NEW CONNCETIONS

Mississippi Missions Mobilization began connecting with this country in 2017. This French speaking country of 10.5 million people is rich in diversity, with over 40 people groups. Over 90% of the population adhere to either Muslim or indigenous religious beliefs. Less than 2% are evangelicals.

The workers in Guinea are serving in both urban and rural settings. The capital city of Conakry is over 2 million people, and a team of workers there is seeking to work with young adults using English and sports to build relationships and share the gospel. They are in need of partners to come and help them in their urban work, which will also carry results back into the smaller towns as a young generation comes to know Christ.

Workers in a more rural area are focusing on one of the largest people groups in the country, the "Fulbe," who are primarily Muslim. Some of these workers have been laboring for two decades, and are seeking partners to come alongside and adopt some of the towns they are not able to get to on a regular basis. There are also a number of unengaged people groups in the country that no one is working with. Imagine town after town where the gospel has never been heard.

Could your church be the one to take the challenge to come to Guinea and see that one of these groups have the opportunity to at least hear the good news? It is not an easy place to engage in, but God is surely calling some to be a part of sowing the seed of the gospel through these opportunities in Guinea.
