### Mississippi is where our hearts call home!

CJ and I grew up in different states, but we met in Alabama and were married in Tennessee in 1995. A few years later, we moved to Columbia, Mississippi, for CJ to serve as student pastor at FBC Columbia. We were blessed with two daughters born in Hattiesburg and the Lord rooted us to this special place called Mississippi.

In 2007, CJ and I went on a mission trip to Bangladesh. While there, we began to feel the Lord stirring our hearts to move our family to the



mission field. On a mission trip to Indonesia two years later, we met a village of people who had never once heard the name Jesus. Being confronted with great lostness and peoples without access to the Gospel, we knew without a doubt the Lord was calling us to be missionaries.

After much prayer and seeking the Lord's direction, our family joined the IMB and moved to a country in Southeast Asia in 2011. With inconsistent electricity and limited access to water, living conditions were

quite challenging, but the people were kind, hospitable, and receptive to us. We saw the Lord do amazing things including salvation, baptisms, and new church plants.

After eight and a half years, we moved to a neighboring country where we continue to serve today. The Lord is moving amongst the people there as well, and we have the privilege of seeing lives changed as we share the Good News of God.

Over our 12 years on the mission field, Mississippi WMU has been a source of encouragement and support for us and our children. We received a monetary gift from MS WMU when we first moved overseas that was especially helpful as we had to purchase items for our initial

setup. Various WMU groups also sent birthday cards to our children each year. Our girls' faces would light up reading the messages from fellow Mississippians. When our girls returned to the States for college, MS WMU provided transportation for them to attend the MK Reentry Retreat where they were supported through their time of transition. Most importantly, MS WMU has been one of the greatest sources of prayer support for our family and our work in Southeast Asia.

We are so thankful for MS WMU. You have blessed us in so many ways! No matter where the Lord might call us to serve Him, Mississippi will always be where we call home.

### AREA WMU WORK \$3,000

Mississippi Women's Ministries/WMU has divided Mississippi into nine areas. Work in each WMU area is led by a coordinator and associate coordinator. MS WMU Edwina Robinson funds assist areas in hosting training, fellowship, and motivational meetings. Assistance may also be provided for special projects.

### MISSIONARY PARENTS FELLOWSHIP \$1,000






