God cleans us up and we start fresh. Some people have not done terrible things in their life, but all were born selfish and we want our own way. We are ALL separated from God and need Jesus. Someone once said if the worst person stood in the deepest part of the ocean and the best person stood on the tallest mountain, neither could reach the stars. That is a good picture of man trying to reach God. It is impossible except that God has reached down to us through Jesus.

No one is born connected to God like He made us to be. Adam and Eve lost that for us when they fell for Satan's lie in the Garden of Eden. (see Genesis 3)

Think of it like this. A part of you, call it your Spirit part, is empty when you are born. It was made to be connected to God and is empty till you choose to let Him fill it. You did that when you asked Jesus to forgive you and told Him He can now be the boss of your life. That is the decision you have recently made and now the real Spirit of God lives in that empty place inside of you.

You are now connected to God through His Holy Spirit- your new helper. This is what you were born to be- in a right relationship with the creator of the universe. Just like your lungs were made to be filled with oxygen, your spirit place was made to be filled with the Spirit of God. You now have that empty space in your life filled, and you will never again have to search for something to fill it.

Jesus died to make this possible. Don't ever forget what your salvation cost the Father and the Son. Thank Him regularly.

The first thing God gave you to help you live this new life –begin again and be successfulis His Spirit. This is the power and presence of God Himself in you. Always remember those two 'p' words. They are two things you need every day.

> He is willing to give you direction. He is willing to give you wisdom. He is willing to give you peace He is willing to give you joy.

But moment by moment every day of your life you must CHOOSE to let Him be in charge. You know from experience your choices make you what you are. This is a choice you will never regret making.

Would you like to have instructions on how to map out your life? The book that is the best seller of all time will do that for you. While the Bible won't tell you who to marry or where to work or go to college, it will give you instructions on many issues you are facing. The very best thing the Bible will do is keep you in God's presence as you read His words from prophets in the Old Testament and from Jesus in the New Testament.

The Bible will tell you the right way to live—the way you were designed by God to live. His way is so good and you don't want to miss it.

In the very beginning (Genesis 3:4-5), Satan told Eve that God was not telling her the truth, but that He was keeping something good from her. She believed Satan instead of God and her life was never the same. She felt shame for the first time. She hid from God and was afraid of Him. (Genesis 3:7-10)

So many people still believe the lies of this world which is still saying that God's way is not good. In fact, they say there is no real right and wrong, but it just depends on the situation.

Read what Jesus says in John 16:13 (NAS):

In John 14:6, Jesus says He is the TRUTH. He came to show us the truth about God and show us that there is a right way to live.

You will only know this truth if you read the Bible. It is a wonderful love letter full of promises that are yours to claim. Remember, everything God tells you to do is because it is best and brings life and peace. (Psalm 84:11-12)

Look around you at people doing life the world's way. Look at the guilt and regret and problems they are causing themselves. List a few problems caused by doing life the world's way in the area of sexual relationships.

We could take many areas of life (friendships, marriage, use of leisure time) and list problems caused by doing them the world's way. Learn this truth early—You will save yourself much heartache by doing life according to the Word of God which you are reading and studying as a daily habit.

Get a good translation that you can understand. Start reading the books listed on the last page of this section and check them off as you finish. Read at least 5 minutes a day. Mark promises and commands. Underline verses that really speak to you and put the date in the margin. Your Bible will become very important to you as you do this. Remember, it is written to you by the creator of the universe.

A few facts about these seven books:

John, Matthew, and Mark are called "gospels" which means "good news." They tell the events of Jesus's life on earth.

I John is a letter John wrote to Christians and it describes what the Christian life should look like.

Philippians, Ephesians, and Galatians are letters written by Paul-a man who traveled the 1st century world telling people about Jesus. He wrote these letters back to churches to instruct them on how Christians should live and remind them of all the things God offers thru LIFE in Christ.



In the past few steps we have been talking about all the things God has provided to help you live the way you were created to live –your helper, your family, and your instruction book. All these things you have learned will only grow more familiar as you get older walking with the Lord Jesus.

This is only the beginning!

This last step is about the new LIFE you are living and LIFE is really the way to describe it. It is "really living."

Read and memorize this verse. It is a truth you don't want to forget. Jesus talking.

John 10:10 (NAS)

The thief comes only to steal, kill, and destroy. I came that they might have life and might have it abundantly.

The Message says it like this: I came so they can have real and eternal life, more and better life than they ever dreamed of.

You have made a choice to give yourself to God. You have asked Him to forgive you and you told Him He was in charge of your life from now on. That is what a LORD is—in charge.

Don't ever forget this decision. It is the best one you will ever make. You were born to follow God, but you had to decide for yourself if you would do it. Because you chose to let God control you by His Spirit inside of you, you are now a complete human. You will live a wonderful life because God will guide your every step. Even when you go through hard things, He has you in

His hand and you know He is there. He gives you peace.

That is if you let Him.

You are his because you decided and now you must decide every day to:

learn more about Him by reading His Word

be in His presence by talking to Him obey Him as He shows you what to do

Those three things will help you do what Paul says in Galatians 2:20- "live by faith." That means you get to follow God step by step, moment by moment, 24/7 for the rest of your life—which, by the way, will only continue after you die. You will then be perfectly in His presence with no sin nature to deal with at all.

Prayer is a vital part of your daily walknumber two in the list above. It is simply talking to and listening to God. Private worship (quiet time) is vital but learn to talk to God all during the day. Jesus wants to be your constant companion thru His Spirit in you. He IS always there, but you must learn to be aware of Him. It is like anything you learn. The more you practice, the more it becomes your life habit.

As you learn to live by faith, God will give you opportunities to share what you know about Jesus with others. Everyone needs Him, many are searching, and it is our privilege to tell them the truth we know.

Continue reading those books you started reading.

Get involved in worship and small group Bible study.

Pray for your friends and family and share Jesus regularly.

It is a wonderful way to live. Don't miss it!
