HOW MANY CHAPERONES CAN WE BRING?

The camp you choose (Connect or Children's) determines the camper-to-chaperone ratio. For Connect Camp, it is 1:5 per gender; for Children's Camp, it is 1:10 per gender. If you would like to bring more than the required ratio, you will be allowed if there is bunk space four weeks before the camp you attend.

HOW DO I REGISTER?

Registration opens on January 8, 2024. Call Cindy Bingham at 662.289.9730 to reserve your camp dates and for instructions on how to register your campers.

WHEN IS MONEY DUE?

A \$50 deposit is due by March 1, 2024, for each camper/chaperone registered. Any cancellations after April 1, 2024, will result in a forfeit of your deposit. Your remaining balance may be paid after registration is completed OR will be invoiced after you arrive at camp and due within 10 business days.
