Hand Bells: **Class limit: 12.** The Handbell choir will be available to both experienced and beginner handbell ringers. The group will prepare and ring an instrumental anthem for the Saturday night worship concert and the Sunday morning worship services. Leader: LuAnne Ford.



Visual Arts: **Class Limit: 20.** No experience required. Using various mediums, you will design/create some type of art to interpret the message of the song “Stand Strong” and will be used at the Saturday night worship concert and Sunday morning worship service. Leader: Christopher & Felicia Hudson.



Orff Instruments: **Class Limit: 10.** This is a hands-on instrument class where students will learn how to play the Glockenspiel, Alto Xylophone and Bass Xylophone to accompany the song “Don’t Be Afraid” as the choir sings. This will be presented at the Saturday night Worship Concert and the Sunday morning Worship.
