REGISTRATION

CHAPERONES

For all camps, the chaperone-to-camper ratio is 1:5 per gender. If housing is available, you may bring more than the required number of chaperones, which will be decided four weeks before your camp date.

Chaperones must be 21 years of age or older and must register online.

DEADLINES

For each registered camper/chaperone, a \$50 deposit is due by February 14, 2025. The deposit is refundable if cancellations are made before April 1, 2025.

Deposits not received by February 14, 2025 will result in the loss of reserved spots.

Any cancellations made after April 1, 2025 will result in a \$50 processing fee in addition to the \$50 non-transferable or refundable deposit.

All campers must be registered online **two weeks before** your camp date.
