

Event Ideas

As you prayerfully plan events with your goals in mind, I wanted to share some things I have done, I have seen done, or I hope to one day do! These are just ideas. You know your people and your resources! Feel free to take them and make them your own! I also have a Pinterest board full of ideas for events! View it here <https://pin.it/8ULJ66HdZ>

Keep in mind that your events should help you achieve your goals and meet the needs of women in your local church! If an event doesn't meet all of your goals don't do it! That doesn't mean it is a bad idea! You can save the idea for the future and move on!

Galentines Party (February)

- Verses: 1 Corinthians 13:4-7, 1 John 4:7-21, Ephesians 2:4-5
- Activities (building community) : Have everyone design a card that represents them and then pass them around so everyone can write on everyone else's card. An encouraging word, a verse, a way that they show Jesus to others, etc., decorate small boxes to fill with candy for your outreach project, make mini flower bouquets
- Outreach : Candy/flowers for widows and widowers in your church, Valentines for the local nursing home or a local ministry

Pajama Brunch (Winter)

- Verses : Psalm 23, Matthew 11:28-30
- Activities : Do a fun craft, watch a Christmas movie, have a pancake bar (could ask people to bring toppings) or ask women to bring brunch foods, everyone wear their favorite pajamas, do a restful activity
- Outreach : Decorate ornaments, wrap gifts for local ministries, go Christmas caroling to church widows/widowers, nursing homes, or your pastor/staff (after an outfit change 😊)

Pumpkin Painting & Pizza (Fall)

- Verses : Psalm 133:1
- Activities : Play music and everyone paint pumpkins, eat pizza, have table talk activities
- Outreach : Have women buy a ticket (buy one get one) and invite a friend who doesn't go to church (plan table talk intentionally with this in mind!)

Women's Night of Worship (Any)

- Verses : Psalm 150:6, Psalm 63:3-4, Psalm 105:1, or Woman at the Well (John 4:1-42) or Hannah (1 Samuel 1:1-2:11) or have a few women share their testimony!
- Activities : Have women around the room to pray with other women
- Outreach : Have women bring something for a local ministry (cans for food drive, diapers for pregnancy center, ask the ministry what would be helpful)

Progressive Dinner (Fall)

- Verses : Hebrews 10:24-25, Acts 2:42
- Activities : Go to different people's houses or to different restaurants for each part of the meal (drinks, appetizers, main course, dessert), do a scavenger hunt that covers all the areas they will travel to
- Outreach : Pray for someone at each restaurant/the host of the home

Friendsgiving (Fall)

- Verses : Psalm 136
- Activities : Big paper on the wall saying "Give thanks to the Lord for He is good" and have ladies write what they are thankful for on the paper or on sticky notes to stick on.
- Outreach : Gather canned goods for local food pantry, pack Christmas gift boxes

Event Ideas

Continued!

Adopt a College/High School Girl! (Outreach: Fall through Spring)

- Activities : Bring her gifts/treats throughout the year, write her notes, send her mail, go to her events
- Outreach : Host a study night at the church for the girls before finals (have breakfast for dinner and coffee and study spaces for them covered in prayers and encouraging notes)

Create Prayer Boards (Activity: any time of year)

- Look on Pinterest for inspo!
- Get your ladies together, gather craft supplies and cork boards, teach women how to pray and talk about the importance of prayer

Tote Bag Painting (Activity: any time of year)

- Bags could be used for Bibles, farmers market, or just fun!

S'more of Jesus (Fall)

- Activity : S'mores, campfire, worship with only guitar and voices, share prayer requests and pray for one another
- Outreach : Invite women from the community to come

Praise & Pajamas (Any)

- Activity : Worship night in jammies!

Bible Study Bookmarks (Any)

- Activity : Divide your ladies up into Bible study groups for one semester and let them create bible study bookmarks their first meeting together to get to know one another before walking through a Bible study together!
- Inreach (focusing on binding your women together in community with one another)

Sundae Sunday (Summer)

- Activity : Ice cream sundaes with alllllll the toppings, conversation cards on the tables, fellowship and connection as the focus
- Inreach

Souper Sunday/Saturday (Fall/Winter)

- Verses: Theme could be resting in God (Psalm 23 or Matthew 11:28-30)
- Activity : Everyone bring a soup and enjoy cozy fellowship
- Inreach

Welcome Baskets (Any)

- Verses: Acts 2:42, Hebrew 10:25
- Activities: Create welcome baskets for women who join your church. Include items like contact information for the women's ministry team, include important dates for your women's ministry, the latest Bible study, a coffee mug, pens/highlighters.
- Inreach: Having the welcome baskets ready to go creates a warm welcome for new church members.

Event Ideas

Continued!

Graduation Parties (May/December)

- Verses: Psalm 100:1-2, Philippians 4:4, 2 Corinthians 9:8
- Activities: Plan a graduation party for the women in your church who are completing significant milestones like high school or college graduations. Consider giving them a monetary gift or a gift card.
- Inreach: Graduation parties are a great way to celebrate the women in your church who have completed a significant step in their education.

Baby Showers for New Moms (Any)

- Verses: Psalm 127:3, Proverbs 17:6, Matthew 19:14
- Activities: Plan baby showers for new moms.
- Inreach: As you plan baby showers for new moms in your church, don't forget to include moms who may be adopting or fostering a child. Those needs may be different, so contact each mom to ask what is needed most as they prepare for their child's arrival.
- Outreach: Contact your local Crisis Pregnancy Center to see if your women's ministry could help host baby showers for clients.

Calling Out the Called (Any)

- Verses: Isaiah 6:8, Matthew 9:38, Matthew 28:19-20, Romans 10:15
- Activities: Actively pray for the Lord to call out women who will commit their lives to full time vocational ministry.
- Inreach: Make sure your students are aware of Discern, a Mississippi Baptist event for high school or college-age students who have experienced a call to vocational ministry or are exploring a call.

Grief Ministry (Any)

- Verses: Psalm 34:18, Matthew 11:28-30, John 11:35, Revelation 21:4
- Activities: Keep an active prayer chain going for needs of women inside and outside your church.

WorldCraft Party (Any)

- Activity : Expands worldviews, teaches women about cultures around the world.
- Outreach : Helping support ministries that impact women all over the world, praying for the lost, praying for missionaries and believers around the world
- Reach out to our office for WorldCraft materials. We would love to partner with you to set up the booths at your church!

Biblical Community

- How do we build biblical community to combat the growing epidemic of loneliness in our world? Join us as we review the biblical principles of hospitality, loving your neighbor, bearing burdens, and discuss practical ways we can create spaces where biblical community is the expectation, not the exception.

Building and Sustaining Intergenerational Relationships

- Are you worried about losing younger generations? Do you feel disconnected from people older than you in your church? In this breakout, we will discuss the power of intergenerational relationships, how to build, grow, and sustain friendships with women of all ages and stages of life, and what it looks like to truly be the family of God.

Teaching Women to Study God's Word

- There are many reasons women may not be studying God's word; they are busy, they have a lot on their plate, but for a lot of them maybe it has never been modeled for them. Join us as we discuss how to get women in the word of God and give them the tools needed to have the confidence to open their Bibles and read them.

Personal Health and Holiness in Ministry

- In a world where many things compete for our time and attention, what does it look like to live a life that is striving towards health and holiness? In this breakout we are going to look at habits that guard against worldliness and push us towards health and holiness in all aspects of our personal lives (spiritual, physical, mental, emotional) and in our ministries.

Sharing your Faith

- The call to live missionally is for all believers! In a disconnected age, it is important that we train ourselves to have intentional, meaningful conversations with people that lead to gospel presentations. Join us as we discuss practical ways for women in Mississippi to live out this call to be the hands and feet of Jesus in your community, your city, in Mississippi, and around the world.

Women's Ministry : Where and how to begin

- Grab your favorite stationary, pens, highlighters, stickers and washi tape as we look at how we can strategically minister to women in our local churches! We will discuss vision and goals for the year for your women's ministry, how to plan events that will make an impact, and how to choose resources to use for Bible studies and small groups.
